NOTIFICATION

MOTOR VEHICLES ACT, 1988.

No. MVR-0423/C.R. 104/TRA-2.— In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (xxxii) of sub-section (2) of section 96 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (59 of 1988), the Government of Maharashtra hereby after, makes the following rules further to amend the Maharashtra Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989, the same having been previously published as required by sub-section (1) of section 212 of the said Act, namely :-

1. These rules may be called the Maharashtra Motor Vehicles (First Amendment) Rules, 2026.
2. In rule 249 of the Maharashtra Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989, the following proviso shall be added, namely :-

“Provided that, it shall not be necessary to have an attendant in a heavy goods vehicles other than articulated semi- trailer vehicles and hydraulic trailers used for carriage of over dimensional consignment, where such vehicle is equipped with a Driver Assist System.

Explanation.—For the purpose of this proviso “Driver Assist System” means 360 degree vision camera covering the entire surrounding area, ensuring coverage of all blind spot and the rear portion of the vehicle and provide the drive with a live feed of the surrounding and also equipped with a proximity alarm system providing both audible and visual 360 degree alerts for the driver and provide external audible warning to alert other road user ensuring that any approaching traffic from the rear is adequately warned and to assist the driver with signals when the motor vehicles is being operated in reverse.”.
